What a joy it was to show the Sandawe people the story and good news of Christ in their own language for the first time and to hear the verse above that the angels told the shepherds on the night of our Saviour's birth.

We received the video just four days before I was leaving the village to return to Canada!

We were able to show it in three different villages on three different nights with a few hundred people attending each night!

Pray that the people will accept and share the good news that they heard and that the Lord will be glorified among the Sandawe people.

I am so thankful for the seven months that the Lord gave me back in Tanzania among the Sandawe people. During that time I witnessed the Lord's blessings in so many ways.

The book of Genesis was completed, more Sandawe Scripture was recorded to audio, the Luke film arrived from the States the week I was leaving, more Bible studies groups were formed, more Sandawe learned to read God's Word in their own language, both Sandawe adults and children professed faith in Christ and Sandawe brothers and sisters stood firm in the faith in the midst of persecution.

I personally have to give thanks to the Lord for His protection and presence with me and for answered prayers.

I did not get sick once during my time there, the Lord gave me safe travels on every trip that I took, He made me aware of snakes, scorpions and spiders that came near me, He helped me teach and develop more Bible studies, and He helped me build deeper relationships. Lots of things to praise the Lord for!
