### Small Group Questions



The following questions are intended to start conversations. Use only the ones your group finds helpful. Explore others as they come up.

Our preaching series this fall will explore the book of Jeremiah (Exiles). A set of questions will be provided each week to help you think about these stories **BEFORE** you listen to the sermon. It is our hope that this will encourage your own study and prepare you for the upcoming series



Read Jeremiah 11:1-17

1. What stands out to you in this passage? Does anything here encourage you or make you uncomfortable?
2. What does this passage show us about the intensity of God's desire for a relationship with His people?
3. How have you seen faith passed down—or lost—between generations? What is one way someone from an older generation impacted your faith?
4. Why do you think God responds so strongly to unfaithfulness? What does that reveal about His character and nature?
5. What are some things we're tempted to trust more than God? What practices can help keep us grounded in God's love and care?
6. How do you see both God's justice and His mercy at work in this passage? How can we live in a way that honors both?
